- ✓ Funded yellow lines to prevent parking on a dangerous bend on Martlett Avenue
- ✓ Replaced churned up verges with neat tarmacking at Bamford Barbers
- ✓ Cleared back growth on numerous ginnels to make them safer to walk through
- ✓ Successfully got the Ranger service reinstated to deal with weeds on houses backing onto Roch Valley
- ✓ Got the bottom of Woodgate Avenue and Fieldhead Avenue added to the resurfacing programme as a priority
- ✓ Sorted broken streetlights,

weed spraying and removal on pavements in various locations

- ✓ Helped with adult care, dog fouling, noise nuisance, speeding issues and worked with the Police to organise speed operations in problem areas

- ✓ We are working with local residents and businesses along with Highways to address the parking and traffic flow problems around the Oulder Hill area

**Councillor Jane Howard said, "We are particularly pleased that after our intervention, Woodlands Avenue, which is in such a poor condition that it is one of the four worst in the borough, will be fully resurfaced as part of the Highways Improvement Programme in the first quarter of 2019. Not a minute too soon."**
