- ✓ Arranged assisted bin collections for elderly residents
- ✓ Funded a traffic survey at Roch Valley Way/Sandy Lane/Bury Road junction
- ✓ Funded speed surveys on Roch Valley Way
- ✓ Cleared several areas of flytipping on Roch Valley Way, Derrick Walker Court and Chadwick Street along with clearing back weed growth along numerous ginnels
- ✓ Successfully got the Ranger service reinstated to deal with weeds on houses backing onto Roch Valley
- ✓ Took action around a vacant house at Sudden causing issues for neighbours
- ✓ Continued to press for work to begin on High Birch School and ensure regular monitoring
- ✓ Paid for yellow lines on the Bent to prevent dangerous parking by Highfield Hospital
- ✓ Sorted broken streetlights, weed spraying and removal on pavements in various locations;
- ✓ Helped with adult care, dog fouling, noise nuisance, speeding issues and worked with the Police to organise speed operations in problem areas

Councillor Jane Howard said, "We are particularly pleased that after our intervention, the drains have been cleared in the area around St.Aidan's Close which will help prevent problems as the winter sets in."
